This event will be Round 1 of the National Orienteering League and a selection trial for the Australian Elites for the World Orienteering Sprint Championships 2026 in Genoa (Genova) Italy. The Knock Out Sprint and the Individual Sprint Championship races will be World Ranking Events and attract WR points.

This will be the Inaugural Sprint the Coast! A first for the Central Coast Orienteers. You will be able to watch the best elites from Oceania battle it out for a chance to go to the World Champs in Italy and then be able to test yourself in the same terrain and challenging courses. Quick decision making will be key to fast times as well as accurate navigation. We have been fortunate to obtain permission to run on never before used areas for 3 out of the 4 events. Plus there's more! You can freshen up on the Sunday morning with a free score event at the beach and treat yourself to a swim and brunch!
